

## UNIT – 2 EXAMINATION

### **Nursery, Jr. KG and Sr. KG :**

The exams will be conducted from 5<sup>th</sup> October to 9<sup>th</sup> October in the school hours. There is no change in schedule for KG. They will have school till 9<sup>th</sup> October.

### **Std. 1 & 2 :**

The exams will be conducted as per the following time-table

7<sup>th</sup> Oct – E V S

8<sup>th</sup> Oct - English

9<sup>th</sup> Oct – Maths

The school timings on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> October are as usual. Bus is available as usual.

**On 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, the students will come to the school as usual ( 8:45 am ) but will leave from the school at 10:30am, immediately after the exam. Please make arrangements at home to receive them. Non bus students should be picked up from the school at 10:30am**

### **Std. 3 & 4 :**

The exams will be conducted as per the following time-table

7<sup>th</sup> Oct – English & Science

8<sup>th</sup> Oct – Maths & Marathi

9<sup>th</sup> Oct – History – Geography - Civics

**There is NO objective exam for Marathi.** For other subjects the objective exams will be on the computer. The objective and the descriptive exams will be on the same day as shown in the above time-table.

There is no negative marking in the objective exams.

In an objective test on the computer, a child can skip a question and go ahead. Once he attempts the last question, the skipped questions will be asked again. The child can again skip and go ahead. This will continue till all the questions are answered or the time of the test is over ( whichever happens earlier )

English textbooks are allowed for English exams (objective and descriptive). Students can bring their own English textbook. Focus is on the language skills, hence students are not expected to memorize material in the text book.

Students can bring their worksheets file of the subject on the given exam day. If they are found carrying any other material to the school, they will not be allowed to take the exam.

**The school timings from 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> October are as usual. Bus is available as usual.**

**On 9<sup>th</sup> October, students will leave from the school at 2 pm. Please make arrangements to receive the students early on this date. Non bus students should be picked up at 2 pm.**

The final scholarship selection test for all 4<sup>th</sup> std students will be taken on 4<sup>th</sup> November during the regular school hours. This will be a computer based test and will be based on all the portion taught so far ( both units )

### **For 4<sup>th</sup> Scholarship students only**

### **Std. 5, 6, 7, 8**

The exams will be conducted as per the following time-table

7<sup>th</sup> Oct – English & Social Studies

8<sup>th</sup> Oct – Maths & Marathi

9<sup>th</sup> Oct – Science & Hindi ( Sanskrit for 8<sup>th</sup>)

Marathi and Hindi objective exams are on paper and for other subjects the objective exams will be conducted on the computer. The objective and the descriptive exams will be on the same day as per the above time-table.

There is no negative marking in the objective exams.

In an objective test on the computer, a child can skip a question and go ahead. Once the child attempts the last question, the skipped questions will be asked again. The child can again skip and go ahead. This will continue till all the questions are answered or the time of the test is over ( whichever happens earlier )
